5. Of such 6,000 shares, vests 500 shares per month from 07/27/07 through 06/27/08. This option is not fully vested, and until fully vested, if exercised, would be subject to repurchase by the Company as to the unvested shares in the event of termination of the reporting person's services as a non-employee director of the Company.
